



## **OBJECTS and BY-LAWS to be read in association with the Ice Racing NSW Inc's Constitution**

### **ARTICLE 1 NAME**

The name of the Club shall be "Sydney Arrows Ice Racing Club" hereinafter referred to as "the Club". The Club is incorporated in the State of NSW using Model Rules referred to in the Incorporation Act, 1984, clause 8.

### **ARTICLE 2 AFFILIATION**

The Club shall be affiliated to Ice Racing New South Wales Inc or its successors or assigns.

### **ARTICLE 3 MEMBERSHIP**

Membership of the Club is open to persons nominated by a financial member of the Club and approved by the committee of the Club.

### **ARTICLE 4 OBJECTS**

The objects of the Club shall be to promote the sport of Short Track Speed Skating among its members, and to extend its membership by such means as are desirable, for example, teaching, coaching and carrying out competitions among the members of the Club. The Club shall not profit from these objectives.

### **ARTICLE 5 COLOURS**

The colours which the Club members shall use as the racing uniform for the Club are NAVY BLUE, ORANGE (i.e. gold) and WHITE.

### **ARTICLE 6 ELIGIBILITY**

The Club shall use, as its definition of eligibility to compete, the standard as laid down from time to time by the ISU or its successors and assigns.

### **ARTICLE 7 RULES FOR COMPETITIONS**

#### **1. Competitions closed to non-Club members**

When the Club carries on competitions open only to members of the Club, then the racing rules set out from time to time, in the Regulation of the ISU, or its successors and assigns, shall be used to govern the conduct of those competitions.

#### **2 Open competitions**

Should the Club wish to carry on competitions that are open to entry from speed skaters who are members of another Club, whatever the affiliation of that Club may be, the Club shall:

a) Seek sanction from the IRNSW to allow non-members of the Club to compete, should

the non-member wishing to complete be a member of another Club with NSW.

b) Seek sanction from the AIRC Inc or its successors and assigns to allow the skaters of the Club to compete should the non-member be from a Club outside NSW.

Note: Under no circumstances shall skaters who are not members in good standing of a Member (i.e. Club) of the ISU, or its successors and assigns, be permitted to compete in competitions organised by the Club.

The Rules for Conduct of such competitions shall be those announced from time to time by the IRNSW Inc.

### **ARTICLE 8 HEADQUARTERS**

The headquarters of the Club shall be the Canterbury Olympic Ice Rink or such other place as the members may decide from time to time, at a General Meeting of the Club.

### **ARTICLE 9 COACHING AND PRACTICE**

The Club committee shall, at each AGM of the Club, appoint such individuals as may be necessary to be Coaches for the members of the Club. Coaching policies shall be set out by these coaches and be available to all members of the Club.

The Club members shall refer to the Club coaches for standards of behaviour and skating at training sessions as organised by the Club. It is also mandatory that skaters who are not member of the Club, but who are desirous of participating in training times arranged by the Club, shall carry out the skating practice at the direction of the Club's coaches. This is necessary to ensure the safety of all who participate at Club practice sessions. In the event that Club coaches are not available, the Club-appointed Safety Officers will be responsible for conduct on the ice.

### **ARTICLE 10 AMENDMENTS**

These by-laws and Objects may be amended by the Club's Committee at a properly constituted meeting of the Committee, always provided that any proposed amendment shall be the subject of a properly set out notice of motion, with adequate notice having been given to the Club's committee.
